CRS Electronics Continues to Increase Sales and Expand Customer Base

March 3, 2010 Welland, ON – CRS Electronics Inc. (“CRS”), (TSX-V:LED), an inventor, developer and manufacturer of LED lighting, is pleased to report that sales, including contract work, school bus lighting, and LED MR16 lamps for the first two months of 2010, increased 60% over the first two months of 2009 to more than \$425,000. Unit sales of the Company’s LED MR16 lamps increased 269% compared to last year.

The increase in sales activity is a result of CRS gaining credibility in the marketplace and expanding its customer base. In recent weeks, the Company has received orders for approximately \$225,000 for LED MR16’s to be shipped in the coming months. Included in these is an order for \$183,000 of CRS’s LED MR16’s to be used in the construction of a new office campus in Boston, Massachusetts. CRS’s LED MR16 lamps were exclusively specified with a ‘no replace clause’ by the project’s lighting designer, Ripman Lighting Consultants, a Boston-based architectural lighting consulting firm. The Company also shipped its second order of LED MR16 lamps to Europe through P. A. SYSTEMS NV a Belgium-based distributor. The lamps were ordered to fill demand in Belgium, Netherlands, France, UK, Germany and Luxembourg.

“It’s quite a validating accomplishment to be specified by a lighting architect for a major installation. We’re pleased to be able to provide a real, sustainable solution to innovative planning for commercial applications,” said Scott Riesebosch, President of CRS Electronics Inc. “Our lighting products are attracting attention and orders from diverse industries and locations worldwide. We see the hotel, resort, and hospitality industry as another market segment that will benefit greatly from the use of our best in class, efficient and economical LED lamps.”

CRS is a leader in the emerging, rapidly-growing market of high efficiency light-emitting-diode (“LED”), or, solid state lighting (“SSL”). The principal activities of CRS include the development, manufacture and sale, primarily in North America, of indoor and outdoor lighting such as LED replacement lamps, LED streetlights, exterior LED warning lights on school buses, child safety systems for school buses and contract manufacturing of LED circuit boards. CRS is a well-established supplier to both the school bus industry and the LED contract manufacturing industry, providing a stable and growing revenue source. CRS plans to be a major supplier of LED light engines for a variety of applications to be developed by CRS on its own and in conjunction with its customers. Several of CRS’s customers use CRS LED MR16 lamps to replace up to 50 watt halogen MR16’s.

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
